
Three Killed in fresh Lagos, Ibadan expressway auto crash

BARELY two weeks after Lagos/Ibadan Expressway carnage claimed yet-to-be ascertained number of lives, it was another cry of agony at the weekend on the same road as another accident occurred, claiming three lives instantly with eight others, who sustained varied degrees of injuries lying in critical condition at the Emergency/Accident Ward of the University College Hospital (UCH), Ibadan.

Eyewitness account disclosed that the accident occurred when the vehicle had burst tyres and in the ensuing confusion, the driver had to apply brake leading to the vehicle somersaulting six times before it rammed into a ditch from where the driver lost control.

The occupants were however lucky with the early arrival of the men of the Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC) and the National President of the National Association of Women Journalists (NAWOJ), Fatimoh AbdulKareem whose brother was among the victims of the accident.
