## Robbery: Angry mob kills suspect in Bayelsa

AN ANGRY mob on Monday in Yenagoa, lynched a suspected armed robber to death, just as the police arrested another suspect, already beaten to pulp, after robbing middle-aged woman, Amina Abekena of the sum of N2m along Sani Abacha road in the state capital.

Two other suspects who carried out unsuccessful operation escaped the wrath of the mob.

An eyewitness account said Abekena was trailed from a commercial bank in the city after withdrawing the money and was heading towards Treasury Building when she quickly suspected that two motorcyclists were behind her.

Worried by the suspected moves of the *okada riders*, the victim ran into the nearby Klin Laundry Service Limited for safety, but the robbers trailed her to the area and collected her car key at gun point.

State Commissioner of Police, Onuoha Udeka, who confirmed the incident said the suspects used the car key to open the boot of the car where the money was kept, noting that after collecting the money, including her blackberry phone, jewelries worth thousands of naira and bangles, the robbers jumped into waiting bikes and zoomed off.
