## Wife stabs husband to death in Ibadan

OYO State Police Command has an herculean task on its hand to unravel the reason behind the stabbing to death of a husband by his wife, simply identified as Mrs. Azeez last Thursday in Kosofe area of Ibadan, the state capital.

Mrs. Azeez, 22, a mother of nine months old baby,

was said to have stabbed her husband three times on the chest during a misunderstanding over domestic allowance on the fateful day in Ibadan South-East Local Government Area of the state. It was gathered that the deceased had given N300 to his wife, who had demanded for domestic allowance from him, while on his way out, but the wife insisted that the money remained N50, and

this, it was learnt resulted in hot argument.

In the process, the wife, a fish seller, was said to have picked a sharp knife, which she uses to cut fish for her customers and stabbed her husband three times at the upper chest.

Though, efforts were said to have been made to rescue the deceased, but he gave up the ghost before any medical assistance could reach him.

The culprit, who was

instantly arrested and taken to Idi Aro Police station, collapsed and shouted when informed about the death of her stabbed husband.

Spokesperson of the Oyo State Police Command, Olabisi Okuwobi, who confirmed the incident, disclosed that the woman is now cooling her heels at the Criminal Investigation Department (CID) of the command, Iyaganku, Ibadan for further
