

One killed, many injured as crisis hits Ekiti NURTW

BARELY four days after the death of five top officials of the National Union of Road Transport Workers (NURTW) in Abuja, a member of the union died in Ekiti State during an intra-union clash.

During the clash, which occurred at the Motor Park Area in Ado-Ekiti, several members of the union sustained various degrees of injuries.

The deceased, simply identified as Femi Aluko a.k.a. Otunba, said to be a loyalist of the incumbent state chairman, Omolafe Aderiye, said to have been accosted by suspected members of a splinter group and stabbed on the stomach.

Those suspected to have carried out the act were said to have opposed to the third term ambition of the incumbent state chairman.
