OOU student raped to death as Ogun police rescue Customs chief from kidnappers

POLICE in Ogun State are working to ascertain the identities of people who raped Sanusi Ruth, a student of the Education Department of Olabisi Onabanjo University (OOU), Ago-Iwoye, to death, Police Public Relations Officer, Muyiwa Adejobi, said on Thursday.

Sanusi was raped to death by unknown persons in her hostel, adjacent Texas Chicken, business premises of the Pro-Chancellor, Alex Onabanjo, as she was inflicted with serious wounds.

This happened as the Commissioner of Police in the state, Musa Daura, said no less than 66 armed robbers were arrested between August 1 and October 20, with the recovery of 2,558 ammunitions.

Daura disclosed this as he paraded two suspects who allegedly kidnapped a Superintendent of Customs, Ekanem John, and demanded a N200 million ransom.

John, 45, was kidnapped just a month after his marriage.

The suspects, Emmanuel Ogugua and Chidi had on Saturday, October 23 allegedly kidnapped John in Apapa area of Lagos at 10.p.m and took him to an unknown destination.
