

Fear grips Jos doctors over murder of colleagues

BARELY five days after members of the Nigeria Medical Association (NMA), Plateau State chapter, staged a protest over the murder of Dr. Osareti Osa-
gie, a consultant with the Jos
University Teaching Hospital
(JUTH), another veterinary doc-
tor has been murdered in Jos.

Daily Independent gathered from Police headquarters that the command has launched serious investigation into the two unfortunate incidents.

It was gathered that on Sunday, residents of Vom community in Jos South Local Council were shocked when the news of the attack on Dr. Ita Umoh, a retiree with the National Veterinary Research Institute (NVRI) filtered in.

Residents in the area told *Daily independent* that they were suspecting robbery while others were of the view that it was an attack by cow rustlers or a case of assassination.

As at the time of filing n this report, the police had confirmed the killing of Umoh, saying that it had commenced investigating into the attack.
