Man lynched in Jos over missing private part

A MAN suspected to be re-sponsible for the disappearance of genital organ of his neighbour after a handshake has been lynched in Mikan Local Government Area of Plateau State.

Addressing journalists in Jos, the state commissioner of police, Abdulraham Akano, said one Nakong of Juliang village in Mikang Local Government Area of the state had reported that after having a handshake with Luka Simon of the same address his genital organ disappeared. According to him, the man raised alarm that attracted the attention of the youths within the vi-cinity and the angry youths attacked the suspect, and stoned him to death.

Akano said the irate youths also descended on the police outpost in the area and damaged it beyond recognition, adding that those responsible for the killing and vandalising of the outpost will soon be

charged to court. In a related development, the police boss said another man that claimed his genital organ was missing and later con-firmed to be faking will soon be charged to court. Akano said one Manchung of Trade Centre, Kuru reported that Francis Um-dom stopped him at Kuru and asked him to direct him to K/ Vom, and instantly felt his genital organ has disappeared.
