

Accident claims three lives in Delta

A LORRY conveying scraps from the eastern part of the country to Delta Steel Company Limited, Ovwian-Aladja on Monday fell while trying to dodge a turning way at Eketé Inland Junction, Udu leaving three people dead.

An official of Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC), who spoke to our correspondent on condition of anonymity, said the incident happened very early in the day and that the lorry might have fallen due to over-speeding.

He said the only surviving person believed to be the driver of the lorry with registration number XA 127 KMR was unable to identify any of the corpses as at the time of filing this report.
