Maiduguri — The police in Borno State have confirmed the killing of a police corporal (names undisclosed) by two gunmen suspected to be Boko Haram members, who fired at him in an ambush attack in Dala Alamderi suburb of Maiduguri the state capital.

The state Deputy Police Commissioner, Usman Baba, said the killed policeman was shot at a local mosque at about 7.30pm on Tuesday, adding that four suspects have been arrested.

Parading the suspects before newsmen at the police headquarters on Wednesday, Baba noted that the four suspects "were arrested after a hot chase by the Joint Military/Police Task Force to their hideouts, where a Kalashnikov rifle and the motorcycle used in killing one of our men and officers that lives in Dala Alenderi ward.
