

Two killed, others injured in road accident

AT LEAST two persons were confirmed dead in an auto crash at the Power Holding Company of Nigeria junction along Warri/Ughelli road last Friday leaving two persons dead and several others seriously injured.

Eyewitness account revealed that the two vehicles, a Mercedes Jeep and Jetta car, had a head-on collision, explaining that the Jetta that had six passengers on board was coming from Warri while the Jeep was coming from the direction of Ughelli when they collided at the PHCN junction, Ekakpamre in Delta State.

Good Samaritans that saw the passengers cry out for help, it was learnt, rushed the victims to the Ughelli Central Hospital.

One of the good Samaritans who preferred anonymity said it took them a lot of stress to remove the passengers from the vehicles as the doors of the cars had jammed.

Confirming the deaths of the unlucky ones, a senior medical doctor at the hospital said that the deceased had internal injuries and had given up before arriving the hospital.

Meanwhile, men of the Nigeria Police Force in-charge of accident crime, at the 'A' Division Ughelli were said to have been working hard to ascertain the cause of the accident.
