

Unknown gunmen
kill two Policemen
in Ikorodu, make
away with guns

TRAGEDY struck in Ikorodu on Tuesday when unknown gunmen attacked a team of armed policemen attached to Owutu Divisional Police Station and killed two men. Also, the two AK-47 rifles the slain policemen were bearing at the time of the attack were snatched and made away by the rampaging armed men.

A sergeant and corporal were felled.

The incident occurred at about 8pm at St Augustine Catholic Church Bus/stop, Oke-Oriya, Lagos Road, Ikorodu West Local Council Development Area.

An informed police source at the station hinted that four armed policemen led by a sergeant who were assigned to a point at St Augustine Church Bus/stop noted to be a notorious flash-point at night were said to be resuming for duty until they were ambushed by the unknown gunmen who rained a hail of bullets on the cops and on the spot two of the policemen were killed and their rifles stolen.
