Police kill two Okada riders in Ondo **By Yemi Akintomide** Correspondent, Akure

Hell was let lose in Okitipupa, Okitipupa Council Area of Ondo State, on Thursday when two Okada riders were reportedly killed by trigger-happy po-

liceman. Evewitness told Saturday Independent that the incident

occurred around 11 pm along Broad Street when a policeman who was on a night patrol alleg-edly demanded N20 bribe from an O*kada r*ider.

The Okada rider simply identified as Akwanga was said to have trifused to part with the money, maintaining that he did not operate that day. This action reportedly infuriated the policeman who alleg-edly shot the Okada rider.

However, in the early hour of Friday, scores of youths believed to be friends of late Akwanga thronged Divisional Police Station in Okitipupa in a bid to avenge the killing. During the process, another person was shot in what an in-sider described as defensive

shooting. Consequently, the youth be-came wilder, and barricaded major roads to prevent vehicular Folies thereafter shot sporadi-cally into the air thereby send-

ing fears down the spine of residents. youths Aggrieved later stormed the police station with

dangerous weapons demanding for the killer of the two persons. Many people sustained serious injuries and are now receiving treatment in various hospitals in the town. It was learnt that other police-

men on duty escaped into the bush for fear of reprisal attack.
