

Okada kills Utuama's younger brother

TRAGEDY struck at Otokutu town Ughelli South council area of Delta State as a motorcyclist (*Okada* rider) rammed into and younger brother to the state Deputy Governor, Mr. Oliver Utuama, in controversial circumstance.

The deceased who was in his early 50's, had many children before he met his un-

timely death.

An eyewitness revealed that trouble started weekend, when Mr. Utuama after picking a passenger from a yet-to-be known location, rode through the busy DSC express way and as the passenger was alighting at Otokutu town, another motorcyclist on high speed crashed into him.

Continuing, the eyewitness said before passers-by could rush Mr. Utuama to a

nearby clinic, he gave up the ghost.

At his residence at Ufuoma street Eketé in Udu Local Government Area of the state, sympathisers wearing heavy faces gathered in clusters discussing the unfortunate incident.

Efforts by our correspondent to speak with the deceased's immediate family proved abortive thought it was learnt that the death of

Mr. Oliver had been communicated to the state Deputy Governor, Prof. Amos Otuama who received it with heavy heart.

A senior police source who does not want his name in print from the Otu-Jeremi Police Divisional headquarter of the Ughelli South Council Area, said the police have not received such news, and thus could not confirm the incident.
