claims two lives, seven sustain injuries break

Ibadan accident

MONDAY sallah turned sour in Ibadan as two people, including a motorcy-cle operator, lost their lives in an incident in which another

seven other people sustained varied degrees of injuries. The mid-day auto crash occurred along Lagos-Ibadan expressway at Muslim Bus

stop and involved a commercial vehicle with registration number TK 363 FST (Lagos), a motorcycle with the registra-

tion number QL 411 KSF (Lagos) and a car with the registration number AA 620 KNR

(Osun). Evewitness said that the commercial bus with the inscription of Jahsco V. Line

Transport, was coming from Lagos and was over speed-ing and the driver lost control

and ran into the motorcycle operator. The motorcycle operator was said to have died on the spot while the passenger lost his life before any medical assistance could reach him. It was gathered that the driver of the commercial vehicle swerved to the other side of the road before hitting the oncoming car and in the process, seven of his passengers sustained injuries and were taken to the nearest hospital for treatment.
