

Kwara Gov's CSO's wife killed

They reportedly ran into an ambush by men of the underworld close to Eyenkorin, a suburb of Ilorin.

To evade the robbers who were robbing unsuspecting travelers of their valuables, it was learnt that the driver decided to escape through reverse which he succeeded in doing undaunted by the several gunshots, the robbers reportedly fired at the vehicle to stop it.

However, while the driver was struggling to escape the

robbers Mrs Mohammed, who was already asleep at the backseat in the vehicle, had already been hit in the head by the bullets having wound down the window during the journey.

A bullet also grazed the driver, it was learnt, though Mohammed's mother and baby escaped unhurt.

Bleeding profusely in the head, the woman was reportedly rushed to two hospitals before she was later taken to the University of Ilorin Teaching Hospital

(UITH) near Oke-Oyi village on the outskirts of Ilorin.

The driver was said to have contacted the Government House's clinic in Ilorin that hurriedly came to convey the injured woman to the UITH where she however later gave up the ghost.

When contacted Sunday afternoon, Police Public Relation Officer of the state command, Ezekiel Dabo, said he was not aware of the development but added that he would on Monday find out what the situation was.
