

Mushin boils again as nursing mother dies in area boys' clash

NOT fewer than eight persons have been arrested by the police in Lagos following last Thursday's clash between two factions of area boys, which left a nursing mother dead.

A stray bullet fired by one of the area boys, it was said, hit the nursing mother, identified as Fatimah, a food vendor.

Eyewitnesses told Daily Independent that the incident occurred at about 8.30pm at Onifade Street, Mushin.

The arrested suspects are currently detained at Special Anti-Robbery Squad (SARS) of the Lagos State Police Command Headquarters, Ikeja.

Daily Independent investigation revealed that a dispute started among the Babalado faction of area boys over the sharing of money realised from importers, who brought in containerised goods to the area. The faction was allegedly led Ola, Poison and Small, who were former members of Babalado group before breaking away.
