

## Eight docked for murder in Osun

**EIGHT** persons were yesterday arraigned before an Osogbo Magistrate Court for alleged murder.

They are Lawrence Dada nicknamed "The Law", Tunde Ajiboye, Adeyemi Joel, Ajibade Adeoye, Omowore Adesoji, Adeniyi Yinka, Johnson Oduyemi and Oduyemi Yinka.

While Dada and Ajiboye were charged for allegedly killing Raheem Mojeed during a protest over the removal of subsidy on petrol by the federal government, the remaining six were arraigned for allegedly killing Komolafe James and Omojola Adesina at different locations. All the suspects were ordered to be remanded at Ilesa Prison custody having been accused of conspiracy to commit felony and murder.

Dada and Ajiboye were accused to have killed Mojeed on January 9 at about 2.45pm at Jaleyemi area in Osogbo. They were also accused of inflicting one Alhaji Fatai Akanbi machete cuts on his right hand at Jaleyemi area of Osogbo.

Five of the suspects were said to have killed Komolafe at Jagun farm, Ifewara via Ilesa and Akinlalu junction in Ipetumodu, Ife North Local Government Area of the state.
