Cultists kill three in Enugu

PROLONGED cult related killings in Enugu continued at the weekend with the killing of a university graduate and two others

The latest victim was identified as the first son of the owner of famous Gad Pharmacy in Enugu. His full name could not be ascertained as at the time of going to press.

Daily Independent gathered that the suspected rival cult members traced the young man to a joint somewhere at Achara Lavout Enugu.

According to a source, the killers identified their target by putting a phone call to his GSM line and as soon as he picked the call, they rained bullets on him.

"They came on motorbike and parked at a distance. The deceased was drinking at joint and a call came into his phone. As soon as he stepped out to answer the call, his assailants shot at him", an eyewitness said.

Our source said that when he screamed and fell down, the killers came very close to where he was lying in a pool of his own blood and shot him twice in the head, before zooming off on their motorbike.

The incident caused stampede in the area as people scampered for safety on hearing the sound of gunshots.
