Bauchi police station burnt, policeman killed

By Patience Ogbodo Correspondent, Bauchi AGAIN, a policeman was killed on Saturday night while another was wounded by unknown gur-men who attacked a police sta-tion in the Itas Gadau Local Gov-

It was gathered that the station was later burnt down by the gunmen after the attack.

When contacted, Bauchi State Police Commissioner, Moham-med Ladan, confirmed the attack with a promise to give details

A security source, who spoke to our correspondent on condition of anonymity, said the gurmen attacked a temporary police station in Itas Gadau, adding that they came to look for arms and ammunition but did not succeed.

In a similar development, a civilian was shot dead by unknown gunmen in Zango area, a suburb of Bauchi metropolis.
