ENUGU STATE Police Command has commenced investigation into the death of a Chinese working at Innoson factory, Emene Industrial Layout, Enugu.

The deceased, identified

Gao Youngqi, reportedly fell from an iron rod while doing welding work at one of the new factories of Innoson Group of Companies in Emene.

He was said to have sustained serious fractures in the accident. which occurred around 12.32 pm on Friday.

According to our sources, he was rushed to Memphis Hospital, Enugu, where he later died.

Youngqi would be a second Chinese in the employ of Innoson Group to die, as few years ago, one of his compatriots at the company died in the custody of kidnappers at Edda forest, Ábakiliki,

Ebonyi State. Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO) in Enugu, Ebere Amarai-

zu, confirmed the report.

According to the police, investigations into the circumstances that led to the death of Gao Youngqi, has commenced.

Amaraizu confirmed that the deceased was said to be working in the Enugu based company when he allegedly fell from iron rod while working in the company's new site.
