

Gunmen kill police orderly to Chime's son

GUNMEN on Monday night killed one of the police orderlies of Nnamdi Chime, son of Governor Sullivan Chime of Enugu State.

The dead police officer was simply identified as Amos.

Although the details of

the circumstances of the cop's death were still not clear as at press time on Wednesday night.

Nnamdi himself confirmed the incident in a posting on his facebook page.

It reads: "One of my security aides lost his life to cold hands of death yesterday. Friends help me to pray

for the repose of his soul. He was a nice man. I have lost a brother. Amos rest in peace."

However, when our correspondent contacted the Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Ebere Amaraizu, he said he was not aware of the incident.

Amaraizu said he has sent signals to all the DPO's

and was waiting for their response, adding that he cannot fabricate something he does not know about.

Chief Press Secretary to the governor, Chukwudi Achife, also said he was not aware of the incident.

"I am not aware of the incident. Nobody told me anything like that", Achife said.
