Robbers kill four Vigilante members in Ogun

ARMED robbers at the weekend shot dead four members of the Ogun State Vigilance Service for daring to foil their operations at a petrol station in the state.

The robbers were reported to have arrived the fuel station at about 8.30pm after parking their vehicle at some few metres to the targeted fuel station.
