UNEASY Calm now

pervades Illushi community in Esan South East Local Government Area of Edo State following violent clashes that have claimed one life. Daily Independent gathered that the clashes

were occasioned disagreements between two rival groups over collection of market revenue in the community. group allegedly backed by the clan head of the community, Chief

Ike Ikebode, investigation revealed, is being resisted by some youths led by the community youth leader, Mr. Jonathan Mawa. After series confrontations, it learnt that one of the

groups allegedly mobilized cultists from neighbouring community to invade Illushi with dangerous weapons, leading to the death of one Abiodun Ojobor and injuring several others.

The community youth leader, Jonatha Mewa alleged that one the sons of the clan head, Christopher

Ikebode, now at large, was responsible for the killing. He appealed to the state Commissioner of Police and the authorities of the local government council provide adequate security for the community, expressing fears that the

invaders could return. Meanwhile, Daily Independent gathered that the clan head, Ikabode, now resides in an unknown place outside the community for alleged fear of reprisal attack form the aggrieved

community youths. Contacted for comments, the secretary to Esan South East Local Government Area, Mr. Solomon Oyedo, saidthosecollectingmarket revenue at Illushi Market

were acting illegally. He condemned the murder, saying no one has the right to take the life of another, and assured that the council will work

with the police to bring the perpetrators to justice. The Esan Area Commander, overseeing the community, Mr. Chris Kanene, confirmed the

incident and disclosed that five suspects had been arrested in connection with the crisis. He however said the situation had been brought under control

following the intervention on his command.
