Vigilantes kill three suspected armed robbers in Warri

THREE out of five suspected armed bandits who specialise in disposing passengers in commercial buses plying Warri and Effurun of their monies and other valuables were killed during a gun duel with men of the Red Bar Vigilante Security Organisation along Warri/Sapele Road, Opposite Total Filing Station, Warri at the early hours of Wednesday.

The suspects were alleged to have succeeded in their operations in one of the commercial buses and ordered the driver of the commercial bus to drop them at the said spot. While coming down from the bus, a brave female victim of the hoodlums raised an alarm, alerting the public about her ordeal which drew the attention of passers by. In the process, the hoodlums took to their heels only to regroup and charged towards the crowd pursuing them with their weapons.

The battle-ready men of the Red Bar Security Vigilante were informed of the situation and they went straight to the scene and engaged the hoodlums in gun duel, which led to three of the bandits getting seriously injured, while the other two, said to be familiar with the area, escaped. It was gathered that the injured bandits died when they were been taken to the police station.
