On Friday, in an attempt to scare a restive crowd after a court session at Kafachan, Kaduna State a police man shot at a woman who later died at an hospital.

Kaduna Commissioner of Police, Femi Adenaike who confirmed the incident disclosed to pressmen that the killing of woman was not intentional.

Adenaike explained a lawyer handling a case at a Court in Kafancha had sought police protection.

He said in attempt to get the lawyer out of the court, the crowd mobbed the police vehicle carrying the lawyer and in the process, one of police men fell from the van, and was attacked, and in self defence, he shot at the woman.

Eyewitness also confirmed to Saturday Independent that the lady was shot by a policeman when the crowd attempted to attack him.

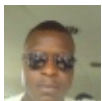
