Prostitute loses two children to night inferno

TRAGEDY struck a middle aged woman in Ibadan as her two children were, on Tuesday night, burnt to death in a room while she was allegedly away on prostitution.

The incident, which happened around Oluyole area of Ibadan, the Oyo State capital, was said to have sent shock waves to the woman.

The report of the incident was made to the Oluyole Police Division of the Oyo State Police Command by the woman's former lover, Jonathan Akamu, and ostensibly, the biological father of the two deceased children.

Akamu, it was gathered, told the police that the distraught woman, simply identified as Gloria Azebamua, had called her on phone around 05.45 a.m and informed him that her two children, Augustina Johnson (8) and Dorcas Jonathan (3), were burnt to death in her room in the area while she went out on night business.

Oyo State Police Command image-maker, Olabisi Clet-Ilobanafor, who confirmed the incident to our reporter, said the report of the incident was made to the Oluyole Division at about 10am yesterday (Wednesday) morning by Akamu according to the signal received at the police headquarters.
