## Headless bodies of cop, herdsman found

IN what looked like  
ritual murders, head-  
less bodies of Divisional  
Traffic Officer (DTO),  
DSP Anthony Ojega,  
and another suspected  
to be a herdsman, have  
been discovered in Ag-  
bor, Delta State, and  
Abudu, few kilometer  
away from Agbor too.

The body of the DTO  
was dumped along Be-  
nin-Asaba expressway  
at Agbor, with a deep  
cut along the neck.

One person has been  
arrested in connection  
with the police officer's  
death.

DSP Charles Muka,  
Acting Police Public Re-  
lations Officer (PPRO),  
confirmed the develop-  
ment, saying the murder  
of the traffic officer has  
remained a mystery, as  
"we don't know what  
happened".

Muka also confirmed  
the recovery of a wom-  
an's corpse at Umunedu  
without any mutilation  
on her body.
