Residents of the ever busy Lagos Street Benin City on Tuesday deserted their homes following the discovery of two headless bodies, whose severed heads were left beside their copses in the area in the early hours of the day.

Reports had it that the two young men who dressed in native attires were allegedly discovered by the side of the road in the Hausa populated area of Lagos Street, Benin City, the Edo State Capital by the residents of the area.

Daily Independent gathered that on discovery the dead men, residents alerted officers at the Oba market police station who later came to remove the bodies to the station without making any arrest.

As at press time, the Edo State Police Command was pondering on the circumstances surrounding the deaths while the residents of the area who fled from their homes earlier for fear of being arrested were seen returning to their homes in trickles as shops in the area still remained closed.

When contacted the Edo state Police Command spokesman, Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP) Moses Eguavoen said he was yet to be briefed on the incident by the Divisional Police Officer in charge of the area.
