Gunmen kill nine, injure four in Gwaram

Gunmen in the early hours of Wednesday April 9, 2014 killed nine persons and injured four in Gwaram Sabuwa in Gwaram Local Government Area of Jigawa State.

Daily Independent gathered that the unknown gunmen, who attacked the town between 2-4am, also bombed the police station in Gwaram Sabuwa, new chairman's office under. construction, and broke the glass doors and windows in the local government secretariat in the area.

According to sources, the gunmen, numbering over 20, were said to have entered the town in cars, threw bombs and killed their victims and left the town without being arrested.

Besides, before leaving the town, the gunmen warned the people to stop enrolling their children in schools, stop accepting polio vaccination and close down all football viewing centres in the town or face another attack.

The nine corpses were deposited in Resheed Shekoni Specialist Hospital mortuary, Dutse while four persons injured are currently receiving treatment at Gwaram General Hospital.

When contacted, the police spokesperson, DSP Abdul Jinjiri, confirmed the story but added that he and Cp Theohilus Kayode and other officers were at the scene of the unfortunate incident trying to get full details of the incident, saying that when they get the details they will brief the press.

The AIG Zone one, Alhaji Tambari Yabo, explained that the unknown gunmen came with motorcycles, and killed seven police men, adding that no arrest had been made so far.
