

Police informant stabs friend to death in Warri

AN alleged police informant resident around the Police "B" Division in Warri, Delta State simply identified as Chuks penultimate Monday stabbed his close friend, Eddy Mukoro to death with a broken bottle.

The incident which happened around 3pm on the fateful day was as a result of Chuks accusing Mukoro and one of his siblings of stealing his generator set, an accusation that sparked off a heated argument that led to fisticuff.

Daily Independent learnt that in the heat of the argument Chuks allegedly took up beer bottle and stabbed Mukoro in the neck region.

This led to his death on the spot as a result of excessive bleeding and is currently lying in the morgue of the Warri Central Hospital.

Following Mukoro's death Chuks was said to have fled immediately with his girlfriend to his Kwale home town for safety.

Meanwhile, following alleged accusation of complicity by some officers of the station that has made the arrest of Chuks, popularly called "inspector" nearly impossible, crack team of officers has been assigned to investigate the matter thoroughly leading to the arrest of Chuks landlord and some persons.

It was gathered that when the incident happened and Chuks ran for cover, his landlord denied ever knowing him but has now allegedly accepted knowing him and is helping the police to locate Chuk whereabouts.
