Man faces trial over murder of school girl

A middle-aged man, Adeniran Wasiu, has been arraigned before an Osogbo Magistrate Court for allegedly killing a primary school girl.

The Prosecutor, Inspector, Ajadi Isiaka, told the Court that the accused committed the offence on June 14 at about 12: 00 noon along Dada Estate Expressway, Osogbo.

Ajadi said the accused drove in a Land Cruiser Jeep with registration Number OGST 181, in a dangerous manner.

He said the accused drove recklessly, which led to the death of one Kausarat Habeeb, 13 years old, a pupil of Ido-Osun Primary School at Ofa-tedo area of the state.

He also stated that the accused was not able to present his vehicle particulars when he was arrested.

The prosecutor said the accused committed a three count-charge and that the offence committed contravened sections 5 and 7, Cap 115 and 146, Vol. 6

of both the Road Traffic Act and Federation of Nigeria, 2003 and 2004.

The accused pleaded not guilty to the charges against him.

Counsel to the accused, Mr. Abimbola Bola, prayed the court to grant his client bail in the most liberal terms.

The presiding Magistrate, Mr. Olusola Aluko, granted the accused bail in the sum of N100,000.00 and two sureties in like sum.

Aluko said the sureties must reside within the court jurisdiction, with evidence of tax payment and two passport photographs, attached with an affidavit of means. The case was adjourned till August 12, 2014, for mention.
