One burnt, three injured in Ibadan auto-crash

An early morning accident in the Idi-Arere area of Ibadan, the Oyo State capital, on Monday, left a commercial bus conductor burnt and three others badly injured.

Our correspondent gathered that the bus with registration number XA 401 LRG, hit a street light pole and caught fire while trying to avoid collision with a child who was crossing the road.

According to Wole Adeniji, who witnessed the accident, after hitting the pole, the bus summersaulted and went up in flames barely two minutes after three of the four persons onboard were rescued.

He added that "the three others in the bus were an elderly woman, a child and the driver... and the bus was loaded with household equipment."

The survivors were quickly rushed to an undisclosed hospital, the source explained, while "the bus conductor simply identified as Tayo was trapped in the bus and could not be rescued when the fire started."

All efforts to contact the state Police Public Relations Officer, Olabisi Ilobanafor, to confirm the incident proved abortive.
