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Man, 28, kills school girl for resisting rape in Ebonyi

Twenty-eight year-old Sunday Nwali of Ezza South Local Government Area of Ebonyi State has allegedly shot dead a secondary school girl, Chioma Ezekele for resisting his attempt to rape her.

The suspected rapist was said to have gone in the company of two accomplices Chukwuma Elom and Friday Ebenyu to the residence of the school girl, but that Chioma resisted all efforts by Nwali, who in annoyance pulled a locally made pistol and shot her.

Commissioner of Police, Ebonyi State Command, Maigari Dikko, on Monday, disclosed this during a press conference in his office, where he explained that the rapist after shooting the girl dragged her friend, Sandra Ajiogu who was with her to a nearby bush, “raped her and vanished into thin air”.

The two accomplices who were later identified by Sandra were later arrested and charged to court for conspiracy/murder.

The police boss who reeled out activities of the command within the past month, also explained that a

gang comprising Uchenna Okereke, Chukwuma Ozoemena and Nwabueze Nwonu, after serving a jail term of 10 years for armed robbery, attacked one Okorie Okorie (a complainant involved in their case).

But, when they got to the man's house at Effium and could not find him, Sunday Nwali who was co-opted in to the gang suggested that they should waste the man's son, and instantly shot the boy dead.

The three suspects have been arrested and remanded in prisons custody.

Dikko used the occasion to assure that following the assumption of office by Suleiman Abba, former Assistant Inspector General of Police, Zone 7, as Inspector General of

Police, the new police management has the vision of leading a national, professional and efficient law enforcement organisation.

"The key points of our redefined mission are: public safety and security, community partnership, prevention of crime, controlling of crime and social disorder", he stated.

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
