Court remands murder suspect in Ibadan prison

A murder suspect, Kazeem Fatai, 30, has been remanded in prison for allegedly causing the death of a 28-year-old man by Ibadan Magistrate Court in Iwo Road area.

The murder suspect was accused of killing the deceased, Sakiru Ogunsola, with a broken glass in the month of April this year, when the two men were said to have been involved in a scuffle which degenerated into a full-blown violence.

The Police Prosecutor, Laro Isiaka, said the suspect committed the crime on April 7, 2014 around 4am and Kazeem, who was represented by F. A. Ijieruka was arraigned on one-count charge of murder.

The charge sheet read, "that you Kazeem Fatai on April 7, 2014 at about 4 a.m. at Mr. Biggs Fast Food, Iwo Road Roundabout, Ibadan, in the Ibadan magisterial district did unlawfully cause the death of Sakiru Ogunsola, 28, by stabbing him with a broken glass that led to his death and thereby committed an offence contrary to Section 316 punishable under Section 319.

The plea of the suspect was not taken by Magistrate E. A. Idowu and was therefore remanded in prison custody and the case was then adjourned to September 12, 2014.
