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Crisis brews in Nasarawa again

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Crisis is again brewing in Nasarawa communities of Ome, Atabula, Adabu, and Abagu, all in Obi Local Government Area.

Already, indigenes are deserting the communities to take refuge in neighbouring villages following the alleged plan by suspected Fulani herdsmen to attack the Eggon villages.

Eyewitness who, claimed anonymity, told *Daily Independent* that the displaced people left their home on **Sunday when the suspected Fulani gunmen again invaded Ome community in Obi Local Government Area of Nasarawa State.**

The source also said the assailants still alerted the community that they would repeat the attack.

The source narrated: “**On Sunday** when every body had come back home as normalcy had returned, then we had ‘suna zuwa’ meaning they are coming; then peoples started scampering in different directions for fear of being killed.”

Daily Independent also gathered that the assailants attacked the community around 1:46pm, shooting sporadically and setting houses ablaze. **They also killed one person and left some injured.**

When contacted, Police Public Relation Officer, Inspector Ismail Noma, on phone he said they were yet to get the report.

It would be recalled that farmers of Eggon origin recently fought Fulani herdsmen, whom they accused of destroying their farmland.

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
