Woman kills deaf mother of two in Ogun

DETECTIVES at Ifo police station in Ogun State are presently interrogating a lady said to be hot tempered for allegedly killing a deaf housewife with fire wood over a bucket.

Sunday Independent gathered that trouble started for the lady, simply identified as Miss Mojisola Opeifa, the hot tempered woman, on October 23, when she had a misunderstanding with the deaf woman, identified as Mrs Aishat Oladipupo, a mother of two, at their residence in Ifo.

According to our source in the area, one Mama Blessing was said to be

fetching water with a small bucket, when the late Aishat decided to help her get a bigger bucket for her.

While Aishat went to fetch the bucket, she was confronted by Mojisola, who claimed to be the owner of the bucket.

However, Sunday Independent further gathered that efforts made by the late woman and some neighbours to convince Mojisola to let go of the bucket, since the late woman had a mark on her bucket, fell on deaf ears.

Mojisola was said to have stormed the 'face-me-I-face-you' apartment of the deaf woman and began argument, which eventually degenerated into a

situation where she used a fire wood to hit the woman on the head, which led to her death.

Husband of the deceased, Oladipupo, who is also said to be deaf, told detectives at Ifo police station, through an interpreter, that it was the height of wickedness for Mojisola to make him a widower and his children, motherless, over a trivial issue of ownership of a bucket.

However, Mojisola, as at the time of filing this report, was still being detained her at the police station, even as police sources said the matter could be transferred to the Ogun State Police Command headquarters for further investigations.
