Hairdresser, two others in trouble over death of 78-year-old man

Detectives in the Ogun State Police Command's homicide department are battling to unravel the cause of the death of a 78-year-old man who was said to have slumped and died after having sex with a lady.

The only person who can authoritatively say what actually transpired is 30-year-old hairdresser and the lover woman with whom the deceased allegedly had sex. She is currently being quizzed at the homicide section of the state Police Command headquarters, Elewera, Abeokuta.

The deceased was said to have slumped and died after several rounds of sex with the suspect at Odogbolu, Ogun State.

Saturday Independent gathered that trouble began on the fateful day when the deceased, identified as Chief Christopher Adebayo Deru, left his home at about 9a.m to visit his 30-year-old woman friend, Ejimo Ibrahim, at No. 65, Febi Street, Off Oladipupo Diya Road, Odogbolu.

During the visit, it was learnt, that the two lovers had sex before the septuagenarian, a chieftain of the Peoples Democratic Party (PDP) in Odogbolu Local Government Area slumped and died.

It was gathered that when the incident happened, the suspect hurriedly arranged with a commercial motorcycle operator and a friend, who at dawn, dumped the remains of the deceased in a bush path as a cover up.

“She concealed the information and didn’t report the matter to the nearest police station, but instead, she looked for ways to dump the corpse in a bush path,” a police source said.

Following her arrest, Ejimo, who operates Temitope Hairdressing Salon, admitted acting wrongly by not reporting to the police, saying she was afraid. Besides, she denied having several rounds of sex with the man, saying that they only had one round of sex he began to gasp for breath.

“That was the first time we had sex since we started dating six years ago. And it was a round of sex that we had, before he began to pant. I think what was responsible was an anxiety.

“Six years ago, we started dating we had never had an opportunity to have fun. When he came in to my room on that fateful Tuesday, he didn’t even rest at all. He began to undress himself the moment he stepped in. Not to seem as if I was not co-operating I joined in undressing myself also.

“When I sensed he was weak I asked him to get off me. I aided him to a single-sitter couch in my room and I started fanning him with a copy of newspaper. Also, I asked him if he had taken his breakfast that morning before coming to visit me at home and he nodded in affirmative.

“His condition persisted and he slumped and died. I became worried and I didn’t know what to do. But the first person that came to mind was my cousin, Segun, a member of Oodua Peoples Congress (OPC). I quickly dashed to his house and narrated to him what had happened. And he assured that he would join me soon at home, but he didn’t surface. When I didn’t see Segun, I contacted Sunday, who subsequently took me to his

sister, Mrs. Funmilayo Moyegun, a friend. Baba gave up the ghost at about 10 a.m. and I locked up his remains inside my room till dawn, precisely 1 a.m. on October 1, 2014 when I sensed every resident in the town ought to have been in door.

Already, I had approached a co-tenant, Benjamin Friday, also, a commercial motorcyclist and a friend, Mrs. Moyegun, a photographer, to help take snapshots of the corpse, and to also take the remains to a bush path, where it was dumped,” the hairdresser narrated.

On how she knew deceased, she said: “It was six years ago in Odogbolu, before I went to Lagos to learn a trade in hairdressing. We didn’t have sex at all, but he was my benefactor. He was a PDP chieftain in Odogbolu town and he was giving me money and also foodstuffs for my upkeep before I went to Lagos, but we never had an opportunity to have fun. He was there for me in times of need. While in Lagos, I met a man who I had a male child for.

“Soon afterwards, I returned to Odogbolu after completing my apprenticeship to set up my own salon and I met another man for whom I had a female child. But because the man was not responsible, as he was not taking care of me and my daughter I left him and I went to hire a room where my daughter and I were staying.

“Even when I got married to the second man, I was seeing the man but we never had sex. It was when I finally separated from the second man that I had time for Baba. We kept the relationship secret. Along the line, Baba and I had a difference when his wife caught us together and I had to retreat out of fear.

“Again, the relationship was renewed sometime in April this year. We changed strategies. We changed venue and time of seeing each other. We chose 9 a.m. because Baba’s wife would have gone to her shop and it would also afford Baba an opportunity to sneak out of his home.

The first time Baba visited me at home was sometime in April, but we didn’t have intercourse, because I was menstruating and Baba felt disappointed. We couldn’t do anything and because he had longed for sex with me he became disappointed.

“The first time we had sex was on that fateful Tuesday, September 30, 2014, which later turned out sour. That very day, I was already on my way to my shop, when I met Baba on his way to my house. He told me, he was coming to my home to play with me. In order not to look as if I was denying him, because he had tried for me, I didn’t turn him down and we returned to my place. We had a nice time, but unfortunately Baba slumped during the first round of sex. That was all,” the 30-year-old suspect narrated.

On why she failed to raise an alarm when Baba slumped, Ejimo claimed that all her co-tenants in the eight-room building had gone out for their various trades, including the farmers among them, and so, she had to lock up the remains of the Baba inside the room and run to her cousin, Segun, for assistance.

Ogun State Police image-maker, Prince Olumuyiwa Adejobi, confirmed the arrest of the three suspects in connection with the sudden death of the 78-year-old politician.

According to Adejobi (DSP), investigation on to get to the root of the matter, adding that a post mortem examination would soon be conducted to ascertain the circumstances leading to the sudden death of the septuagenarian.
