## FG arraigns artist for alleged murder

**The** Federal Government on Monday arraigned a 32-year-old artist, Asawah Joshua, before an FCT High Court for allegedly killing his friend, Tobi Emmanuel.

The Prosecution Counsel, Mrs Amina Dhacko, told that the court the accused committed the offence in January 2011 at Utako District of FCT in Abuja.

Dhacko said that the accused absconded after the incident.

She said that the accused is standing trial on a one-count charge of culpable homicide, an offence punishable with death.

Joshua, however, pleaded not guilty to charge.

In view of his plea, the prosecuting counsel then prayed the court to fix a date to enable her present witnesses.

Counsel to the accused, Mr Olulemu Adetola, asked the court to admit the accused to bail in most liberal terms pending the determination of the case.

“My lord, the essence of bail is for the accused person to attend his trial,” he said.

Adetola argued that the accused had expressed willingness to attend his trial.

He further argued that the prosecution did not file any counter affidavit to his application.

“My lord, bail is granted in special circumstances,” he submitted.

The prosecution, however, opposed the bail application.

She, however, prayed the court to grant her a short adjournment to enable her reply on points of law.

Presiding Justice Folasade Ojo granted the prayer and adjourned the case to November 28 for hearing.
