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Lagos: Police arraign driver for killing tricycle rider in Ajah

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The police in Lagos have arraigned a 35-year-old bus driver, Tunde Folorunsho, for allegedly causing the death of a tricycle rider.

Folorunsho, a resident at No. 11, Isale Ijebu Road, Ajah, Lagos, is facing a two-count charge of dangerous driving and driving without a licence.

Police prosecutor, Chidi Okoye, told the court that Folorunsho caused the death of Mr Ikpe Udoabasi at 8.00 a.m. on September 17 at Badore, Ajah, Lagos.

He said the accused drove dangerously without due care and attention to other road users and consequently hit a commercial tricycle, instantly killing the driver, Udoabasi.

Okoye said three passengers in the tricycle sustained serious injuries.

The prosecutor also submitted that investigations revealed that Folorunsho was driving without a licence.

According to him, the offences contravene Sections 18 and 22 of the Road Traffic Act of Lagos State, 2012.

Folorunsho, however, pleaded not guilty.

The Chief Magistrate, Mrs A.O. Awogboro, granted him bail in the sum of N250,000 with two sureties in like sum. Awogboro adjourned the case to January 19 for mention.

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
