Woman found dead in Akure market

THERE WAS pandemonium on Wednesday when the lifeless body of a 28-year old woman simply identified as Biola was found on the Oja Oba area of Oba Adesida Road in Akure, the Ondo State capital.

In the confusion, bewildered residents of the area scampered for safety when the lifeless body of deceased was seen in the pool of her blood.

The remains of the deceased was found on the floor close to the traditional King's market, also known as Erekesan Market in front of the palace of the Deji of Akure in the ancient town.

Our correspondent gathered from traders at the market that the deceased was hale and hearty just the day before (Tuesday) and was seen moving round all the shops at the market as she went about her business before the close of the day's trading activities.

One of the traders told our Correspondent: "We saw her yesterday (Tuesday) greeting people in the Market and she was full of life to the extent that she assisted some people at the market."

It was learnt that the mother of deceased also trades in the market, while the deceased engaged in petty trading.

Details of the death of the deceased could however not be ascertained as at press time, as there were different factions of the cause of her untimely death.

The Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO) for the state Police command, Wole Ogodo confirmed the incident, but said he has not been properly brief.

He said the Police would investigate the matter and make the cause of accident public soon.
