

Trailer smashes car, kills driver in Kajuru

A trailer conveying plastic rubbers heading towards Kano from Kaduna State has reportedly smashed a blue coloured Carina 11 car, killing the driver instantly.

According to an eyewitness, Mr. Danladi Bako, the trailer was at full speed and wanted to

overtake the Carina 11 at a fast lane, but lost control and then hit the car.

This resulted to instant death of the driver of the car.

Bako, who said he was returning from his farm walking along the foot path when he heard the sound of trailer that smashed the Carina car, added that he and other passers-by scampered for safety thinking it

was Boko Haram that invaded the area in broad day light.

The accident, which occurred at 10.00 a.m. along Kasuwa Magani road in the Kajuru Local Government area of the state, killed only the occupant of saloon car.

"The driver died immediately while the car was smashed into pieces. It is so bad that I don't pray to even see such a deadly

accident in my life.

"The car was shattered into smaller components because both the Carina and the trailer were on high speed," Bako said.

He appealed to the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) and other security agencies to always put road signs in strategic places to caution drivers of excessive driving.
