Man, 23, remanded in prison for beating guard to death





A 23-year-old man, Bulus George, has been remanded in prison on the orders of a Federal Capital Territory High Court for beating a security guard to death.

Presiding Justice Ajoke Adepoju said on Thursday that the accused should be kept behind bars pending when his bail application would be heard.

She said that since it was a capital offence he required a lawyer to represent him.

George, who has been in police custody for over one year, was alleged to have attacked and killed a security man, Aigbe Moses, in Lugbe, Abuja, following a misunderstanding.

The accused, who allegedly hacked the guard to death with four others still at large, is facing a two-count charge of criminal conspiracy and culpable homicide. He, however, pleaded not guilty.

The prosecution told the court that George and others committed the offences on October 25, 2014 and were subsequently arrested by the police the same day.

At the resumed hearing of the case on Thursday, the prosecution counsel, John Ijagbemi, told the court that an application seeking to press a criminal charge against the accused had been filed.

Ijagbemi urged the court to give a date to enable him to open a case against the accused.

The case was adjourned to March 9 for ruling on the bail application.
