Man Choked To Death At Fuel Station In Delta

TRAGEDY struck at a popular, filling station around the garage area of Warri in Delta state, Tuesday, when a middle-aged man identified as Okechukwu Okoyo who went underground to bail water from the under surface leaking tank of the station was choked to death by gas emission in the airtight confinement.

Late Okechukwu who hails from Enugu state was the car wheel balancing/alignment attendant attached to the fuel station lubrication department until his untimely death.

The incident occurred around 5-6pm in the evening and was said to have been brought out and taken straight to the Warri Central Hospital morgue by his brother, whom some called "Prince" at the filling station while at the mortuary his name was given as Mr. Ene Chidiebere.
