When owners and staff of Silverbird TV and Rhythm FM, were trying to put behind the death of their employee and colleague, Aisha Noble-Mustapha, another tragedy struck as Ifeoma Aggrey, a presenter on Rhythm FM, died of gunshot wounds after a robbery attack last Tuesday.

Noble-Mustapha was shot dead at the Aba-Port Harcourt road on her way from a visit to her parents in Aba. The bus as learnt was attacked by some robbers and in the process of the bus driver escaping, the robbers opened fire on the bus which resulted in Aggrey's death. As at press time, it was not confirmed if she was the only passenger that died in the bus.



Iphie

Hours before the incident, she posted some tweets which however were not related to the attack. On her tweeter handle where she was known as Iphie Aggrey-Fynn, she tweeted; "Meanwhile Port Harcourt refuse dumps on fleek...pls who's in charge, the couple hav still not danced in. Thank God for the bread n caprisonne I ate in the car. I gave patience for this Nigerian jollof."

Aside been an on air personality, Aggrey was a writer and motivational speaker. To confirm this report and get reaction from the management of Silverbird Communication, several calls were made and none was answered. However, an unidentified staff expressed ignorance of the incident and promised to confirm from other colleagues and call back. As at press time the call was not returned.

Born to a Nigerian mother and a Ghanaian father, Aggrey-Fyn Ifeoma was a graduate of Linguistics and Communication studies, Abia State University. She started her journey into broadcasting in 2003 as a TV presenter. She joined Rhythm FM in 2009. Iphie started her radio career at Rhythm 95.7 Awka where she presented the mid morning show "Rhythm n Soul", Gospel Vibes and "E-Merge" a TV programme on STV Awka.

She was later moved to Rhythm PH in 2011 where she brought her unique style to a different audience through the different drive shows she features in. From the Morning Drive to the Afternoon Drive and the Dance Party including her unique news reading skills, Iphie has been known to be an all rounder.

She has also found a name for herself as an event host and public speaker.
