



Police Discover Corpse With Bullet Wounds In Bauchi

The Police in Bauchi state has discovered a yet to be identified human corpse with bullet wounds along Tafawa Village, Boto district in Tafawa Balewa Local Government Area of Bauchi State.

According to a statement made available to Journalists by the Bauchi State police Command on Friday by the Police Public Relations Officer, DSP Haruna Mohammed, the corpse was discovered by the Police patrol team attached to Tafawa Balewa Division while they were on patrol.

Haruna said "Scene of the incident was visited by Police detectives and a dark blue Toyota starlet without registration number suspected to be that of the victim parked by the road side was also discovered at the scene.

"After a thorough search was conducted inside the vehicle, the following items were found, duplicate copies of vehicle particulars bearing the name ABDU BALI male of Jimeta, Yola with registration number YLA 222 GG, Chassis no JTI52EE-BIO3106762 Which corresponded with the recovered Vehicle, One handcuff and some bunch of keys. and a brown envelope and one exercise book".

"The victim was photographed and rushed to the. Abubakar Tafawa Balewa ATBU Teaching Hospital Bauchi where he was certified dead by a medical Doctor.

The PPRO said the corpse was deposited at the Motuary for postmortem examination.

He thereby advised any member of the public who have useful information about the victim to report at the State Criminal Investigation Department Bauchi or nearest Police station to enable the police identify relatives of the victim.

Mohammed said the Case is under investigation adding that effort is on to apprehend the fleeing suspects.
