Four Persons Burnt To Death As Trucks Collide In Awka

Four persons were burnt to death in Awka, Anambra State capital, when two trailers collided on Saturday.

The accident occurred at about 6.35pm at the Immigration Junction where a trailer crushed a couple and their son to death three weeks ago.

The two vehicles burst into flames on collision, sending billow of smoke to the sky.

As a result of the collision, the Onitsha/Enugu dual carriageway was barricaded, resulting in traffic gridlock.

The police and men of the Federal Road Safety Commission worked tirelessly to clear part of the road to allow for flow of traffic.

Most motorists had to turn and pass through the premises of Nnamdi Azikiwe University, Awka.

Eyewitnesses said the two trucks were on high speed when the accident occurred.

This latest accident has heightened the call on Governor Willie Obiano to construct a flyover bridge on the spot to prevent further recurrence, as the incident had become frequent.
