Arrests Galore: Police Nab Fake Army Officer, Armed Robbers In Imo

One Samuel Ngozi (M) from Isiala Ngwa council area of Abia State, who has been parading himself as a Major in the Nigerian Army has been arrested by the police in Imo State.

The Imo State Police Command said that he was arrested while terrorising residents of Nekede, in the Owerri West council area of the state.

The Acting Commissioner of Police, Mr. Dave Akinremi, who confirmed the arrest while parading the suspect along with other suspects, before newsmen, said that the suspects were nabbed following a tip off and would be charged to count for impersonation and an attempt to commit felony.

According to Akinremi, the command also apprehended one Kelechi Ihemegbulam, a 22- yearold graduate of Information Science from the Abia State University, Uturuwho he said belonged to a notorious fraternity "Brotherhood".
