# Arrests Galore: Police Nab Fake Army Officer, Armed Robbers In Imo

One Samuel Ngozi (M) from Isiala Ngwa council area of Abia State, who has been parading himself as a Major in the Nigerian Army has been arrested by the police in Imo State.

The Imo State Police Command said that he was arrested while terrorising residents of Nekede, in the Owerri West council area of the state.

The Acting Commissioner of Police, Mr. Dave Akinremi, who confirmed the arrest while parading the suspect along with other suspects, before newsmen, said that the suspects were nabbed following a tip off and would be charged to count for impersonation and an attempt to commit felony.

According to Akinremi, the command also apprehended one Kelechi Ihemegbulam, a 22-year-old graduate of Information Science from the Abia State University, Uturu who he said belonged to a notorious fraternity "Brotherhood".

According to the CP, Ihemegbulam, until this ar-

rest, was in the wanted list of the command for his involvement in the murder of several persons within and around the state as well as cult-related activities and had since made useful statement and would soon be charged to court.

Akinremi also spoke of the arrest of one Stanley

U. Uzoma (M) of Umuelele Amazano in the Njaba Council area and one Adekiye, Apapa of Okariki Ngele, Ahoada West LGA of Rivers State in connection with unlawful possession of firearms and attempt to commit felony.

He added that a suspected ritual murderer/ child traf-

ficker, Joy Emmanuel, a resident of Amaifeke Orlu and a native of Eziobodo in the Owerri west council area has also been arrested by the police.

The suspect according to the CP conspired with one Blessing Emmanuel from Imi, in Akwa Ibom State who was delivered of a set

of twins to murder and sells one of the babies to a native doctor at the cost of N100,000.

Additionally, Akinremi said that the Command also acting on a tip off arrested one Izuchukwu Unamadu (alias Obodinka) of Ududumiri Ezinamba in Oru West LGA believed to be a member of a three man syndicate responsible for the kidnap of one Chidiebere Nwokocha (m) of Umuayachu Ubulu in Oru West council area of the state.

Also arrested were three armed robbers, Chigozie Nduka of Umuoba Uratta from Owerri North Council area; Chimankpa Duru (m) from Umuonyeche in Owerri Municipal council and Ikechukwu Obiefula (m) from Umuodu also in Owerri Municipality, who were arrested in their bid to execute an armed robbery/kidnap operation on Douglas Road of the city.

The police boss who exhibited all the weapons recovered from the suspects appealed to members of the public to always supply the police with useful information that would assist them in their operations in their own interest.
