## T.B. Joshua Honors Collapsed **Synagogue Building Victims With Memorial Service Today**

Prophet T.B. Joshua, founder of the Synagogue Church of All Nations (SCOAN), will today hold a memorial service in honor of the victims of the September 12, 2014 building collapsed within the church premises in the Ikotun area of Lagos.

The SCOAN owned collapsed six-storey guest house claimed the lives of 116 people, mostly South Africans.

The church, in a statement said the memorial service, which is to commemorate the first anniversary of the unfortunate incident, would hold in South Africa.

According to the statement, Prophet T.B Joshua had sent a delegation from Nigeria to take part in activities leading to the memorial. Joshua, who described deceased as Martyrs of Faith, maintained that they were on an appointment with God when they met their death and therefore believes that they did not die in vain.
