## Multiple Bomb Blasts Kill 64, Two Soldiers, Injure 90 In Maiduguri

MAIDUGURI

Maiduguri, the Borno State capital, was again thrown into another Pandemonium on Sunday night when five multiple suicide bomb blasts killed not less than 64 innocent residents of Ajilari Cross and Lawan Jidda Street of Gomari areas of Maiduguri metropolis.

The blasts also killed 2 soldiers and wounded over 90 others.

The PPRO Borno State Police Command, ASP Victor Izukuof, confirmed the attacks and casualties to newsmen Monday in a telephone conversation.

NEMA officials similarly confirmed the incident but gave 45 as the total number of casualties.

A resident of Ajilari Cross one Baana Dala told Daily Independent that "around 7. 20 pm when Muslims gathered in a mosque at the Ajilari Cross bus stop for Isha prayer, a heavy bomb blast occurred, killing over 43 people and injuring over 34 others."
